District 4-C1 has received a total of \$8,350.00 designated for the Carr Fire that have passed through the California Lions Foundation. We appreciate the Foundation's efforts to see that these funds have been directed to our District 4-C1 Relief Fund.

The immediate needs of those affected by the Carr Fire have largely been met. We are now focusing on the needs of those rebuilding. We are in contact with the Community Relief Team, a consortium of about 50 service organizations whose purpose is to fill unmet needs of the fire victims.

Lions of District 4-C1 will be assisting in handing out 700 free beds that will be arriving around the first of November. The district will be purchasing bedding to go with each bed that goes out. We will also be in close contact with the Community Relief Team to take care of any need of a fire victim that may arise, i.e. needs for kitchen utensils, bedding, clothes, etc.

Twenty homes were lost during the Delta Fire. District 4-C1 is working with the Lakehead Lions Club to meet any unmet needs there.
